As a result, 1.5 million New Yorkers will lose their healthcare from Medicaid and the Essential Plan. This will also result in a \$3 billion budget deficit for the state next year and will be a recurring year-over-year deficit.  The Medical Aid in Dying Act passed both houses this year after first being introduced into legislation over a decade ago. While ANA-NY had not previously taken a position on this legislation, the Legislation Committee voted to support this legislation, and ANA-NY will be issuing a letter of
